

## The School's Commitment

### We will aim to:

- Nurture your child in a caring catholic Ethos, showing them respect, understanding and develop them to be confident, happy learners;
- provide your child with a moral framework within which he/she will play a full and positive part in the community;
- be welcoming and open to all parents, and offer you opportunities to become involved in school life;
- provide a happy, secure and stimulating learning environment for your child;
- provide your child with a balanced and broad curriculum that is tailored to meet her/his individual needs and to encourage your child to fulfil her/his potential offer a high standard of teaching across the curriculum;
- ensure your child's safety whilst at school; and consistently enforce the school's discipline and anti-bullying policies at all times;
- keep you regularly informed of your child's progress through consultation meetings, reports, letters, newsletters and fully informed about school events;
- discuss with you promptly any concerns there may be, as appropriate;
- reward children's achievements by praise and encouragement.

## The Pupil's Commitment

### I know that I am expected to:

- do my best at school;
- arrive in the classroom on time, first thing in the morning and during the school day keep the school rules and to understand the consequences of not doing so;
- be polite, friendly and considerate to all staff, visitors and pupils;
- look after our school, our equipment and our environment and to respect property belonging to others;
- do my homework every day
- wear my correct school uniform each day;
- bring my PE kit on the correct day and only wear it on this day.

### The Parents'/Guardians' Commitment

#### I/we will aim to:

- To show commitment to the teaching of the Catholic faith by praying with my child, taking them to mass and instilling the catholic values in my home and by supporting all liturgical events where possible.
- ensure my/our child attends regularly and on time. I will notify the school on the morning of each first absence, in line with the policy detailed in the school prospectus;
- ensure that my/our child is only absent from school for health reasons or for holidays approved in advance by the school;
- ensure that my/our child wears the correct school uniform every day;
- encourage my/our child to work hard at school and provide a suitable environment at home for homework. I undertake to check and sign homework each day;
- become familiar with the approaches of the school as outlined in the school prospectus;
- support the school's behaviour, discipline and anti-bullying policies;
- inform the school promptly of anything which may affect my/our child's behaviour or performance at school and any changes in home circumstances or personal details, eg change of name, address, emergency telephone number or doctor;
- support my/our child and the school by attending relevant meetings, eg: parent meetings, curriculum meetings, open days, school events, assemblies etc;
- return necessary correspondence (consent forms, reply slips, etc) by the required date;
- encourage my/our child to take responsibility for her/his own actions and to realise their commitment to the school.
